Masha classes – no pads

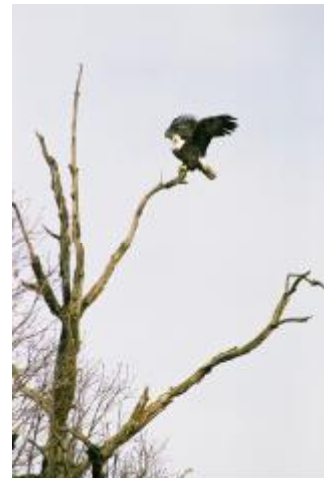
LASHA will follow USEF rules, and that will be stated in the prize list (which has been done in the past).

The American Saddlebred Horse

The American Saddlebred was developed by 18th century colonists who sought a good-looking, sensible and adaptable animal.

The American Saddlebred is the personification of the ultimate show horse. She carries herself with an attitude – she is alert, with her neck arched, head up and ears forward, every movement saying, "Look at me!"

American Saddlebreds have the distinct ability to perform

five gaits. All Saddlebreds are able to perform at the walk, trot and canter; in addition some have the ability to be trained to slow gait and Rack. The slow gait is a highly collected gait with each of the four feet striking the ground separately. The rack is a fast, exciting four beat gait in which the hoof meets the ground at equal, separate intervals. The slow gait and rack give a very smooth ride.

American Saddlebred Horses are highly intelligent and can be easily trained to accomplish many tasks.

The breed registry was formed in 1891 and was the First such organization for an American Breed of horse.

The American Saddlebred is truly "The Horse America Made."
